Thank you so much for offering to help with the trees fallen at my house. I give my permission and consent to your doing whatever you deem necessary to remove the trees and patch or cover the roof. I release you from any liability related to this undertaking. We did the work at your home today. You had one double trunked tree that came down in the yard, on your back patio roof and a little on your back room roof. The back room only has damage in the soffit area so no water leakage inside. It mostly looks like some of the damage is old rot? The back patio roof is smashed in.

Another tree went through the back corner of your second story and did a lot of roof damage. We were able to remove that as well and put a tarp over the opening. You'll need to get this repaired as soon as possible as the tarp is only temporary.

We cut up the trees and moved the limbs to the curb out back on Gum Branch Road. There is also some damage to the air conditioner unit outside, but it looks like it is just cosmetic, but I'm no A/C guy.

I hope your surgery goes well. Some of your neighbors were asking about you. I've attached some pictures for you to see.
